1 My Favourite Place in Carterton

Choose a place in Carterton that you like (e.g. a park, shop, school, library, leisure centre, church or somewhere else).

2 People Who Help in Our Community

Find out about someone who helps people in Carterton (e.g. a doctor, nurse, police officer, firefighter, teacher, shop worker, postal worker, librarian, vet).

Create a poster, picture or model to tell us about their job and how they help our local community.



3 Carterton Through Time

Find out what Carterton was like in the past and what it is like now.

You could compare old and new photos, draw pictures, make a poster or timeline, or write a few sentences about the changes.



4 Our Natural Environment

Explore the natural world around Carterton. You could look at plants, trees, animals, or what you might see on a walk.

Create a nature collage, drawing, model or a photograph with labels.



5 Map It Out

Create a map of Carterton.

You could draw a simple map and include important places (e.g. your school, homes, parks, shops, roads), or make a 3D model using recycled materials.

Label the places and add a key (if you can!).
