1 Roman Life

Find out what daily life was like in Roman times. You could choose to research:

- homes
- food and cooking
- clothes
- entertainment
- family life

Present your findings as a poster, fact file, model or presentation.

What would it have been like to live in Roman times?



2 Roman Warriors

Create a model, drawing or information booklet about a Roman soldier. You could include:

- their armour and weapons
- how they were trained
- what life was like in the army
- the Roman formations (e.g. testudo)



What made the Roman army so successful?

4 Roman Inventions

The Romans invented many things we still use today!

Choose one Roman invention

(e.g. roads, aqueducts, concrete, underfloor heating, calendars) and find out:

- what it was
- how it worked
- why it was important
- whether we still use it today

Which Roman invention do you think is the most important? Why?



3 Roman Britain

Find out about the impact the Romans had on Britain. You could research:

- Roman towns (e.g. Bath, Chester)
- roads and buildings
- new inventions and ideas
- Boudicca and the Iceni
- how Britain changed

Present your learning as a poster, model, storyboard or even a short video.

What evidence can you find in Britain today?



5 A Roman Creative Challenge

Use your imagination to create something inspired by the Romans. This could be:

- a mosaic (using paper, card, buttons or natural materials)
- a Roman-style piece of pottery (model or design)
- a Roman menu
- a piece of jewellery
- a comic strip or story set in Roman times



Get creative – what will you design?

6 A Famous Roman

Choose a significant Roman person (e.g. Julius Caesar, Emperor Claudius, Boudicca) and create a fact file, poster, presentation or role-play about them. Include:

- key facts
- what they achieved
- why they are remembered
- your opinion – were they a hero or a villain?

Who was the most influential Roman? What do you think?
